1812 CHAPTER 161

XVII Not to prevent proceeding by ordinary Course of Law if thought more advisable.

Provided always, and be it further enacted, That nothing herein contained shall extend or be construed to extend to prevent His Majesty from proceeding by Information in His Court of Exchequer, or from having Recourse to any other Law which may now exist for the Punishment of Offences of the Nature herein-before mentioned, in all Cases where such Proceedings -shall be deemed more advisable than those which are authorized by this Act.
