CHAPTER 46

CIVIL LIST AUDIT ACT 1816 (REPEALED)

- 1—7
- 8 Treasury may appoint an officer to audit the civil list accounts; such officer not to sit in Parliament.
- 9 Treasury to prepare instructions for the guidance of such officer.
- 10 Officer may summon persons, and require books accounts and vouchers and examine upon oath.
- 11
- 12 Officer, after examination, to make out states according to instructions. Treasury may remit for further examination, or allow any warrant under sign manual upon such allowance to be final discharge.
