

Civil List Audit Act 1816

1816 CHAPTER 46

Certain Sums heretofore paid to a Part of the Royal Family out of the Civil List to be hereafter payable out of Consolidated Fund.

That from and after the Fifth Day of *April* One thousand eight hundred and sixteen, the Payment of the several Allowances and Sums of Twelve thousand Pounds to His Royal Highness *Frederick* Duke of *York*, of Two thousand five hundred Pounds to His Royal Highness *William Henry* Duke of *Clarence*, and of Four thousand Pounds to each of Their Royal Highness the Princess *Augusta Sophia*, the Princess *Elizabeth*, the Princess *Mary*, and the Princess *Sophia*, heretofore granted by His Majesty, and charged upon the Civil List Revenues, shall cease and determine, and such Allowances and Sums of Money shall be no longer payable or paid out of the said Revenues ; but from and after the said Fifth Day of *April* One thousand eight hundred and sixteen, the said several Allowances and Sums of Money respectively shall be charged and chargeable upon and issuing and payable out of the Consolidated Fund of *Great Britain*, during the Joint Lives of His Majesty and Their said Royal Highness respectively, as to each of Their said respective Allowances and Sums aforesaid.
