1816 CHAPTER 46

IX Treasury to prepare Instructions for the Guidance of such Officer.

And be it further enacted, That it shall be lawful for the Lord High Treasurer, or the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury for the Time being, or any Three or more of them, and they are hereby required, as soon as conveniently may be after the passing of this Act, to prepare a full and complete Code of Instructions for the Guidance of the Conduct of such Auditor in the Execution of his Duties as aforesaid ; and it shall be lawful for the Lord High Treasurer, or Commissioners of the Treasury for the Time being, or any Three or more of them, from Time to Time to alter and change such Code of Instructions, or to issue any additional Instructions for the Conduct of the said Officer, in such Manner as the Good of His Majesty's Service may from Time to Time appear to them to require and such Officer for the Time being shall in all Cases in the Execution of his Office govern himself in the Performance of his Duties therein by such Instructions, in like Manner in every respect as if the same had been inserted and made Part of this Act.
