1816 CHAPTER 46

XIII In case of Exceeding Particulars to be laid before Parliament.

And be it further enacted, That whenever the total Charge upon the Civil List, from the Fifth Day of *January* in any one Year, to the" Fifth Day of *January* in the succeeding Year, shall amount to more than One million one hundred thousand Pounds, an Account stating the Particulars of such Exceeding, and the Cause thereof, shall be submitted to Parliament within Thirty Days after the same shall have been ascertained, if Parliament shall be then fitting; but if Parliament shall not be then fitting, then the said Account shall be presented within Thirty Days after the next Meeting of Parliament.
