1816 CHAPTER 50

An Act to regulate the Sale of Farming Stock taken in Execution. [20th June 1814]

WHEREAS it is expedient that the Execution of legal Procefs, should be fo regulated, as to be confitent with good Hufbandry, and the Effect and Intent of Covenants and Agreements entered into between the Owners and Occupiers of Land let to farm;

be it enacted by the King's molt Excellent Majeffy, by and with the Advice and Confent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this prefent Parliament affembled, and by the Authority of the fame,
