



# Public Offices (Scotland) Act 1817

1817 CHAPTER 64

An Act to abolish certain Offices, and regulate others, in *Scotland*. [7th July 1817]

WHEREAS certain Offices in *Scotland* require to be regulated, and it is expedient that certain other Offices in that Part of the United Kingdom should be abolished :

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted ; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same,
