

# Vestries Act 1818

### **CHAPTER 69**

## **VESTRIES ACT 1818**

- [1.] Three days notice to be given of vestries; by publications in the church, and affixing on church door. Chairman of the vestry appointed to have a casting vote. Minutes to be entered and signed. Manner of voting in vestries. 4 Inhabitants coming into a parish since the last rate may vote. 5 Provisions in relation to parishes extended to townships, &c. Manner of giving notice of vestries and meetings in special cases. 8 Not to alter time for holding vestries, specially directed; nor to affect vestries held under special Acts, &c. 9 Not to extend to London;
  - 10 nor to Southwark;
  - 11 to extend only to England and Wales.
