## **CHAPTER 38**

## **COURT OF SESSION ACT 1821**

- Power to remit, with Instructions on Bills of Advocation and Suspension of final Judgments.
- II Procedure on Bills of Advocations of Removings.
- III Regulations in certain Cases of Equality of Voices.
- IV Provision in case of the Death, Sickness, &c. of the Lord Ordinary on the Bills during Session, but when the Court is not sitting.
- V Court may remit Processes of Reduction to be decided by the Lord Ordinary.
- VI Principal Clerks of Session alone to be capable of holding the Office of Principal Clerks of the Bills.
- VII Proviso in favour of the Clerks of Session now in Office.
- VIII Salaries to the Clerks of the Bills.
  - IX Principal Clerk of Teinds, to be an Advocate or Writer to the Signet of Three Years standing.
  - X Provision for the better conducting the Business of the Teind Court.
- XI Direction of Brieves to the Macers in Services prohibited.
- XII Writers to the Signet to be Clerks to such Services.
- XIII Provision for Contingent Expences incurred under Authority of the Court.
- XIV Keepers of the Inner House Rolls and Clerks of the Judges to receive Salaries.
- XV Annual Allowance to Keepers of Inner House Rolls, &c.
- XVI Duties of Keeper of the Outer House Rolls to be performed by Clerks of Eight Judges.
- XVII Extracts to be prepared by Extractors to be appointed.
- XVIII Duplicates for the Record, and Abbreviates of Adjudications, to be signed by the Extractors.
  - XIX Extractors to be appointed by the Principal Clerks of Session.

- XX Salaries to Extractors.
- XXI Compensation to Preparers of Extracts.
- XXII. Principal Clerks Assistants to be Members of the College of Justice.
- XXIII Act of Sederunt to be made with regard to unextracted Processes.
- XXIV Certified Copies for Appeals, &c. may be signed by the Clerks Assistants.
- XXV Fee for comparing certified Copies for Appeals.
- XXVI Keepers of the Register of Deeds, &c. to be appointed by the Lord Clerk Register.
- XXVII Indexes of certain Registers to be formed.
- XXVIII Fees of Macers regulated, and Salaries provided for diem.
  - XXIX Remuneration to the Collector of the Fee Fund.
  - XXX Disposal of Balance of Fee Fund, and Deficiency to be supplied.
  - XXXI Fees may be diminished or abolished by the Court; and a Copy of the Order transmitted to the Secretary of State, to be laid before Parliament.
- XXXII Office of Auditor of the Court of Session to be made permanent. During temporary Indisposition, &c. a Person to be appointed to discharge the Duties of Auditor.
- XXXIII Decreets in Absence not to be extracted without the Account of Expences being taxed by the Auditor.
- XXXIV Compensation to certain Officers.
- XXXV Fund from which Compensation shall be made.
