



# Births and Deaths Registration Act 1926

1926 CHAPTER 48 16 and 17 Geo 5

## 4 Prohibition of removal of body out of England without notice.

The body of a deceased person shall not be removed out of England until the expiration of the prescribed period after notice of the removal has been given to [<sup>F1</sup>the senior coroner in whose area the body is situated,] or otherwise than in accordance with such procedure as may be prescribed, and any person contravening the provisions of this section shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding [<sup>F2</sup>level 3 on the standard scale].
