1932 CHAPTER 26

5 Declaration in Act of Queen Anne not to be required of principals of or professors in Scottish Universities.

It shall not be necessary for any person who shall have been, or shall be, elected, presented or provided to the office of principal, professor, regent, master or other office in any of the universities or colleges in Scotland to make and subscribe the acknowledgement or declaration mentioned in an Act passed in the fourth session of the first Parliament held in Scotland by Her Majesty Queen Anne, initial "Act for securing the Protestant religion and Presbyterian Church Government."
