An Act to provide for the information to occupiers of the amount of the rates payable for the houses which they occupy. [22nd July 1919]

Provisions with respect to demands and receipts for rent in which any sum for rates is included. E+W

- (2) This Act shall not apply to weekly lettings at inclusive rentals in any market established under or controlled by statute.

2 Definition. E+W

The expressions "demand for rent" and "receipt for rent" shall include a rent-book, rent-card and any document used for the notification or collection of rent due or for the acknowledgment of the receipt of the same.

3 Penalty. E+W

If any person makes a demand for rent or gives a receipt for rent in contravention of this Act, he shall, in respect of each offence, be liable on summary conviction to a fine of not exceeding [F2] level 1 on the standard scale].
