AMENDMENT OF THE SMALL LANDHOLDERS (SCOTLAND) ACT, 1911

15 As to land within burgh in crofting counties.

Notwithstanding anything contained in paragraph (*c*) of subsection (3) of section twenty-six of the Act of 1911, or in the reference to that paragraph in subsection (4) of the said section, a person shall be admissible to registration as a new holder under the Act of 1911 in respect of land within the parliamentary ^{F1}... boundary of any burgh ^{F1}... situate in the counties of Argyll, Inverness, Ross and Cromarty, Sutherland, Caithness, and Orkney and Shetland.
