

# Agriculture (Scotland) Act 1948

#### 1948 CHAPTER 45 11 and 12 Geo 6

#### PART VII GENERAL

Provision of Goods and Services.

### 75 Schemes for provision of agricultural goods and services.

(1) For the purpose of promoting efficiency in agriculture or facilitating food production, the Secretary of State may with the approval of the Treasury make schemes for providing . . . <sup>FI</sup> services to persons managing or farming agricultural land.

Any scheme under this section shall be embodied in a statutory instrument which shall be laid before Parliament after being made.

- (3) The Secretary of State may make such reasonable charges, if any, as he thinks fit in respect of . . . <sup>F1</sup>services provided in pursuance of a scheme under this section.
- (4) The Secretary of State may acquire by agreement any land which he requires for the purposes of a scheme under this section.
- (5) Section one hundred and three of the MIAgriculture Act, 1947, shall, in so far as it applies to Scotland, cease to have effect, and anything done by the Secretary of State or any scheme made under that section shall be deemed to have been done or made under this section.
