



# Public Registers and Records (Scotland) Act 1948

1948 CHAPTER 57 11 and 12 Geo 6

## 2 Provisions as to recording in Register of Sasines.

The following provisions shall have effect with regard to the recording of writs in the General Register of Sasines—

- (a) the names and designations of the presenters of writs shall not be entered in the minute book;
- (b) each page of the minute book shall be signed by the Keeper of the Registers of Scotland or by a deputy duly authorised by him in that behalf, and no further signature shall be necessary for the authentication of the minute book; and in particular it shall not be necessary that the minute book be signed by the presenter of a writ or in the case of a writ transmitted to the Register by post [<sup>F1</sup>or electronically] by a clerk in the office of the said Keeper;
