Proceedings for infringement, etc.

61 Counterclaim for revocation in action for infringement.

A defendant in an action for infringement of a patent may, without presenting a petition, apply in accordance with [FI rules of court][FI rules made under section seven of the MI Northern Ireland Act 1962] by way of counterclaim in the action for revocation of the patent.
