



# Pet Animals Act 1951

1951 CHAPTER 35 14 and 15 Geo 6

## 3 Pets not to be sold to children under twelve years of age.

[<sup>F1</sup>If any person sells an animal as a pet to a person whom he has reasonable cause to believe to be under the age of twelve years, the seller shall be guilty of an offence.]
