

Rivers (Prevention of Pollution) Act 1951

1951 CHAPTER 64 14 and 15 Geo 6

An Act to make new provision for maintaining or restoring the wholesomeness of the rivers and other inland or coastal waters of England and Wales in place of the Rivers Pollution Prevention Act 1876, and certain other enactments; and to provide for laying before Parliament the annual reports of river boards. [1st August 1951]

Modifications etc. (not altering text)

C1 Act repealed (*prosp.*) by Control of Pollution Act 1974 (c. 40, SIF 46:4), Sch. 4 which repeal is no longer prospective save s. 5(1)(c)(6)(7), s. 11(1) so far as it defines "stream", ss. 11(6), 12(1)(3)
