GENERAL

44 Short title, commencement and repeal.

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Arbitration Act, 1950.
- (2) This Act shall come into operation on the first day of September, nineteen hundred and fifty.
- (3) The ^{M1}Arbitration Act, 1889, the ^{M2}Arbitration Clauses (Protocol) Act, 1924, and the ^{M3}Arbitration Act, 1934, are hereby repealed except in relation to arbitrations commenced (within the meaning of subsection (2) of section twenty-nine of this Act) before the commencement of this Act, and the ^{M4}Arbitration (Foreign Awards) Act, 1930, is hereby repealed; and any reference in any Act or other document to any enactment hereby repealed shall be construed as including a reference to the corresponding provision of this Act.
