1942 CHAPTER 17

An Act to approve a Treaty signed on behalf of His Majesty and on behalf of the President of the United States of Venezuela relating to the Island of Patos. [21st May 1942]

WHEREAS the treaty set out in the Schedule to this Act has been signed on behalf of His Majesty and on behalf of the President of the United States of Venezuela:

And whereas His Majesty desires that the said treaty may be approved by Parliament before being ratified:

And whereas it is expedient to give such approval:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
