5 Meaning of “physical injury”.

For the removal of doubt it is hereby declared that the expression “physical injury”, in the principal Act and in this Act, and in the ^{M1}Personal Injuries (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1939, includes tuberculosis and any other organic disease, and the aggravation thereof.
