SCHEDULE

Constitution, Jurisdiction and Procedure of Pensions Appeal Tribunal

- [^{F1}2B (1) A President of Pensions Appeal Tribunals and a Deputy President of Pensions Appeal Tribunals may be appointed for [^{F2}Scotland or Northern Ireland]
- (2) The person entitled to appoint a person under this paragraph to be a President or Deputy President of Pensions Appeal Tribunals shall be—
- (a) ^{F3}
 - (b) in the case of an appointment for Scotland, the Lord President of the Court of Session; and
 - (c) in the case of an appointment for Northern Ireland, the [^{F4}[^{F5}Northern Ireland Judicial Appointments Commission]].
- (3) Only legally qualified members of a Pensions Appeal Tribunal shall be eligible for appointment under this paragraph.
- (4) A person shall cease to be President or Deputy President of Pensions Appeal Tribunals if he ceases to be a member of any such Tribunal.
- (5) The Deputy President of Pensions Appeal Tribunals for [^{F6}Scotland or Northern Ireland] shall carry out such of the functions of the President for [^{F7}Scotland or Northern Ireland] as that President assigns to him.
- (6) If at any time the President of Pensions Appeal Tribunals for [^{F6}Scotland or Northern Ireland] is temporarily unable to carry out his functions under this Schedule, those functions shall be carried out by the Deputy President for [^{F7}Scotland or Northern Ireland].]
