

Marine And Aviation Insurance (War Risks) Act 1952

1952 CHAPTER 57 15 and 16 Geo 6 and 1 Eliz 2

9 Expenses of the Minister of Transport.

The expenses incurred for the purposes of this Act by the [F1Board] shall, except in so far as they are required to be defrayed out of the marine and aviation insurance (war risks) fund, be defrayed out of moneys provided by Parliament.
