CHAPTER 26

PIRACY ACT 1850

- II Jurisdiction given to the High Court of Admiralty and all Vice Admiralty Courts.
- III List or Return of all Cases to be sent to the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty.
- IV Rewards for Services against Pirates by Vessels in the East India Company's Service.
- V Property of Her Majesty's Subjects found in possession of Pirates to be restored on Payment of One Eighth of Value.
- VI Persons giving false Evidence deemed guilty of Perjury.
- VII This Act may be amended, &c.
