BILLS OF LADING ACT 1855 (REPEALED 16.9.1992)

- 1 Rights under Bills of Lading to vest in Consignee or Endorsee.
- 2 Not to affect Right of Stoppage in transitu or Claims for Freight.
- 3 Bill of Lading in Hands of Consignee, &c. conclusive Evidence of Shipment as against Master, &c. Proviso.
