

Duchy Of Lancaster Lands Act 1855

1855 CHAPTER 58 18 and 19 Vict

An Act to better enable the Chancellor and Council of the Duchy of *Lancaster* to sell and purchase Land on behalf of Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, in right of the said Duchy of *Lancaster*. [16th July 1855]

Whereas it is expedient that the Chancellor and Council of the Duchy of *Lancaster* should be better enabled to sell Land belonging to the said Duchy which in the Judgment of the said Chancellor and Council shall be deemed not convenient to be held with other Possessions of the said Duchy, and to purchase Land which in the like Judgment shall be deemed convenient to be held with other Possessions of the said Duchy:
