1856 CHAPTER 56 19 and 20 Vict

41 Jurisdiction of sheriffs and justices in Exchequer cases saved.

Nothing in this Act contained shall operate to prevent the exercise by any [F1sheriff principal] or justice of the peace in Scotland of any jurisdiction at present competent to such [F1sheriff principal] or justice respectively.
