Constitution of the University

5 Establishment of Council of the Senate.

.....^{F1F2} ... The Council of the Senate^{F2} ... shall consider and prepare all graces to be offered to the Senate, whether proceeding from individual members of the Senate or from syndicates; and no grace shall be offered to the Senate without the sanction of the major part of those voting upon it in the Council.
