ECCLESIASTICAL COURTS JURISDICTION ACT 1860

- 2 Penalty on persons found guilty of making a disturbance in churches, chapels, churchyards, or burial grounds.
- 3 Offenders may be, immediately after offence committed, apprehended, etc.
- 4 Persons aggrieved may appeal against conviction.
