1865 CHAPTER 27

An Act for awarding Costs in certain Cases of Private Bills.

[26th May 1865]

WHEREAS it is expedient to empower Committees of both Houses of Parliament on Private Bills to award Costs in certain Cases:

Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, as follows:
