

Queen Anne's Bounty Act 1840

1840 CHAPTER 20 3 and 4 Vict

An Act to amend an Act passed in the First Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the First, intituled "An Act for rendering more effectual Her late Majesty's gracious Intentions for the augmentation of the Maintenance of the Poor Clergy"; and to render valid certain Agreements which have been made in pursuance of the said Act; and for other purposes. [3rd July 1840]
