1868 CHAPTER 96 31 and 32 Vict

19 Notice of appeal.

The sheriff clerk shall within two days after the date of any appeal being taken send written notice of such appeal to the repondent or his agent: Provided, that the failure to give such notice shall not invalidate the appeal; but the Lord Ordinary may give such remedy for any disadvantage or inconvenience thereby occasioned as may in the circumstances be thought proper.
