1869 CHAPTER 107 32 and 33 Vict

Extension of interpretation of term "common" in 29 & 30 Vict. c. 122^{M1} .

The following words shall be added to the interpretation of the term "common" in the third clause of the Metropolitan Commons Act, 1866; namely, "and any land subject to be included under the provisions of the eighth and ninth Victoria, chapter one hundred and eighteen."
