6 Payment of commutation moneys.

The Commissioners for the Reduction of the National Debt, . . . F1 , may pay the amounts awarded as commutations of pensions out of any funds for the time being in their hands under the authority of $[^{F2}$ the M1 National Savings Bank Act 1971] . . . F3
