## *Legal Proceedings*

### **20 Summary proceedings for offences, &c.**

In England and Ireland all offences and penalties under this Act may be prosecuted and recovered in manner directed by the Summary Jurisdiction Acts, before a court of summary jurisdiction.

In Scotland all offences and penalties under this Act shall be prosecuted and recovered before a court of summary jurisdiction under the provisions of [<sup>F1</sup>Part II of the <sup>M1</sup>Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1975], and all necessary powers are hereby conferred on such court.
