



Parks Regulation Act 1872

1872 CHAPTER 15 35 and 36 Vict

7 Powers, duties, and privileges of park-keeper.

Every [^{F1}park constable] in addition to any powers and immunities specially conferred on him by this Act, shall, within the limits of the park of which he is [^{F1}park constable], have all such powers, privileges, and immunities, and be liable to all such duties and responsibilities, as any police constable has within the [^{F2}police area] in which such park is situated; and any person so appointed a [^{F1}park constable] as aforesaid shall obey such lawful commands as he may from time to time receive from [^{F3}the Secretary of State] in respect of his conduct in the execution of his office.
