

House of Commons Costs Taxation Act 1879

1879 CHAPTER 17

1 Powers of 10 & 11 Vict. c. 69 extended to provisional orders and other cases.

All the powers and provisions of the above-recited Act shall extend and apply to the costs, charges, and expenses of any parliamentary agent, solicitor, or other person in respect to the obtaining or promotion of or opposition to any provisional order or provisional certificate, or any Bill for confirming the same; and in respect to the promotion of any Bill by any public trustees or commissioners, or by any municipal or other public authority, and in respect to the opposition to any public and general Bill.
