1843 CHAPTER 86 6 and 7 Vict

38 Complaints to be made within [^{F1}twenty eight] days.

All complaints under the provisions of the London Hackney Carriage Act, 1831, or of this Act, or of the orders and regulations made in pursuance of either of them, ^{F2} . . . , shall be made within [^{F1}twenty eight] days next after the day on which the cause of complaint shall have arisen.
