

Lands Clauses Consolidation (Scotland) Act 1845

1845 CHAPTER 198 and 9 Vict

Purchase of lands by agreement

8 Parties under disability may exercise other powers.

The ^{FI}... power to discharge lands from any rent, payment, charge, ^{FI}... or other real burdens or incumbrances, and to agree for the apportionment of any such rent, payment, charge, ^{FI}... or other real burdens and incumbrances, shall extend to and may lawfully be exercised by every party herein-before enabled to contract for, sell, dispose of, or convey lands or rights or interests therein to the company.
