

# Railways Clauses Consolidation (Scotland) Act 1845

1845 CHAPTER 33 8 and 9 Vict

Recovery of damages and penalties

## 136 Penalty for defacing boards used for such publication.

If any person pull down or injure any board put up or affixed [<sup>F1</sup>for the purpose of publishing any byelaw of the company or any penalty imposed by this or the special Act], or shall obliterate any of the letters or figures thereon, he shall forfeit for every such offence a sum not exceeding [<sup>F2</sup>level 1 on the standard scale], and shall defray the expences attending the restoration of such board.
