1831 CHAPTER 32 1 and 2 Will 4

26 Exceptions as to innkeepers.

[^{F1}Provided always, that it shall be lawful for any innkeeper or tavernkeeper, without any such licence for dealing in game as aforesaid, to sell game for consumption in his own house, such game having been procured from some person licensed to deal in game by virtue of this Act, and not otherwise.]
