The Atomic Energy Authority (Appointed Day) Order, 1954

Made - - - - 24th June, 1954

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 24th day of June, 1954

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas by subsection (2) of section eight of the Atomic Energy Authority Act, 1954(a), the expression "the appointed day" is defined as meaning such day as Her Majesty may by Order in Council appoint:

Now therefore, Her Majesty, in pursuance of the said subsection, is pleased by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. The appointed day for the purposes of the Atomic Energy Authority Act, 1954, shall be the first day of August, nineteen hundred and fifty-four.
2. This Order may be cited as the Atomic Energy Authority (Appointed Day) Order, 1954.
