# The Industrial Assurance (Premium Receipt Books) (Amendment) Regulations, 1961

Made	24th March, 1961
Laid before Parliament	30th March, 1961
Coming into Operation	1st April, 1961

The Industrial Assurance Commissioner, with the approval of the Treasury, in pursuance of subsection (2) of Section 8 of the Industrial Assurance and Friendly Societies Act, 1948(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. For sub-paragraphs (b) and (c) of Regulation 1 of the Industrial Assurance (Premium Receipt Books) Regulations, 1948(b), there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraphs:—
  - "(b) the name of the life assured as stated in the proposal or the life assured's present name, and his age as stated in the proposal or such corrected age as may have been entered in the book with the authority of the owner of the policy;
  - (c) the name of the proposer as stated in the proposal or the proposer's present name; ".
- 2. These Regulations may be cited as the Industrial Assurance (Premium Receipt Books) (Amendment) Regulations, 1961, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1961.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

Regulation 1 of the Industrial Assurance (Premium Receipt Books) Regulations, 1948 (which prescribes particulars of industrial assurance policies to be entered in premium receipt books) required those books to show names and ages as they appeared in the proposal. These amending Regulations allow as alternatives the entry of the present name and of a corrected age.
