WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY

The Marine, &c., Broadcasting (Offences) (Jersey) Order 1967

Made - - - 23rd August 1967 Coming into Operation 1st September 1967

At the Court at Balmoral, the 23rd day of August 1967 Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in pursuance of section 10(1) of the Marine, &c., Broadcasting (Offences) Act 1967(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

- 1. The Marine, &c., Broadcasting (Offences) Act 1967 shall extend to the Bailiwick of Jersey with the exceptions, adaptations and modifications specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Marine, &c., Broadcasting (Offences) (Jersey) Order 1967 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1967.

SCHEDULE

Exceptions, Adaptations and Modifications in the extension of the Marine, &c., Broadcasting (Offences) Act 1967 to Jersey

- 1. The words "Bailiwick of Jersey" shall be substituted for the words "United Kingdom" in the following places where the latter words occur, that is to say, sections 1(1) (first and third places), 2(1), 4(1)(a) (first and third places), 4(2), 5(1)(a) (first and third places), 5(2), 9(1) (in the definitions of "external waters" and "the high seas") and 9(2) (first place); and in section 6(3) the word "Jersey" shall be substituted for the words "any place in the United Kingdom".
 - 2.—(1) For section 6(1) there shall be substituted the following subsection:—

 "(1) A person guilty of an offence under this Act shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or to a fine or to both.".
 - (2) For section 6(4) there shall be substituted the following subsection:—
 - "(4) Proceedings for an offence under this Act shall be taken before the Royal Court and may be instituted at any time after the commission of the offence."

- (3) In section 6(5) the words from "in England" to "in Northern Ireland" and the words "for Northern Ireland" shall be omitted.
 - (4) For section 6(6) there shall be substituted the following subsection:—
 - "(6) A member of the Honorary Police of a parish and a member of the States of Jersey Police Force shall, for the purpose of the enforcement of this Act, have in external waters all the powers, protection and privileges which each has respectively in that parish and in any parish whilst at the disposal of the Honorary Police thereof under the Police Force (Jersey) Law 1951.".
 - (5) Section 6(8) shall be omitted.
- 3. In section 9(1) at the end of the definition of "wireless telegraphy" there shall be added the words "as extended to Jersey by the Wireless Telegraphy (Channel Islands) Order 1952(a)".
 - 4. Section 11(2) shall be omitted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order extends the Marine, &c., Broadcasting (Offences) Act 1967 to the Bailiwick of Jersey with exceptions, adaptations and modifications.
