The Wireless Telegraphy (Channel Islands) Order 1967

Made - - - 23rd August 1967 Coming into Operation 27th August 1967

At the Court at Balmoral, the 23rd day of August 1967

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in pursuance of sections 16(1) and 20(3) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949(a) and of section 15(6) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1967(b), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

- 1.—(1) Sections 9 to 12 and 15 of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1967 shall extend to the Channel Islands with the exceptions, adaptations and modifications specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- (2) Accordingly, in paragraph 2 of the Schedule to the Wireless Telegraphy (Channel Islands) Order 1952(c) the word "British" wherever it occurs shall be omitted.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Wireless Telegraphy (Channel Islands) Order 1967 and shall come into operation on 27th August 1967.

SCHEDULE

EXCEPTIONS, ADAPTATIONS AND MODIFICATIONS IN THE EXTENSION OF SECTIONS 9 TO 12 AND 15 OF THE WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY ACT 1967 TO THE CHANNEL ISLANDS

- 1. In section 9(1) the references to the United Kingdom in the first two places shall include references to the Channel Islands.
- 2. In section 9(2) the reference to a ship or aircraft registered in the United Kingdom shall include a reference to a ship or aircraft registered in any of the Channel Islands.
- 3. In section 9(3)(a)(i) for the words "United Kingdom" where they first occur there shall be substituted, in the case of the Bailiwick of Jersey the words "Bailiwick of Jersey", and in the case of the Bailiwick of Guernsey the words "Bailiwick of Guernsey".
 - 4. Section 9(5) shall be omitted.

- 5. In section 11(1) there shall be omitted sub-paragraph (ii), the word "or" immediately before it and the word "summary".
- 6. In section 11(3) there shall be omitted paragraph (b) and the word "and" immediately before it.
 - 7. In section 11(4) the words following "as he thinks fit "shall be omitted.
- 8. In section 12(1) for the words "United Kingdom" in both places there shall be substituted, in the case of the Bailiwick of Jersey the words "Bailiwick of Jersey", and in the case of the Bailiwick of Guernsey the words "Bailiwick of Guernsey".
- 9.—(1) In the case of the Bailiwick of Jersey, for section 12(2) and (3) there shall be substituted the following subsection:—
 - "(2) For the purpose of the enforcement of the principal Act, a member of the Honorary Police of a parish and a member of the States of Jersey Police Force shall have in any area of the sea within the seaward limits aforesaid all the powers, protection and privileges which each has respectively in that parish and in any parish whilst at the disposal of the Honorary Police thereof under the Police Force (Jersey) Law 1951.".
- (2) In the case of the Bailiwick of Guernsey, section 12(2) and (3) shall be omitted.
- 10. In section 15(3) the words "apparatus for wireless telegraphy" shall be omitted.
 - 11. Section 15(5) shall be omitted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order extends certain provisions of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1967 to the Channel Islands with exceptions, adaptations and modifications.
