The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 20(4) of the Civil Evidence Act 1968, hereby makes the following order:—

- 1.** Sections 11 and 12 of the Civil Evidence Act 1968 shall come into force on 2nd December 1968.
- 2.** This order may be cited as the Civil Evidence Act 1968 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1968.
