**The Salford Hundred Court of Record (Extension of
Jurisdiction) Order 1970**

Made - - - - - 4th June 1970
Coming into Operation 1st July 1970

I, George Morgan Thomson Chancellor of the Duchy and County Palatine of Lancaster in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 3(1) of the Salford Hundred Court of Record Act 1911(a) as amended by subsection (2) of section 83 of the Manchester Corporation Act 1954(b) and all other powers enabling me in that behalf hereby order and direct that as from the first day of July One thousand nine hundred and seventy the jurisdiction of the Court of Record for the Hundred of Salford shall be extended so as to include personal actions within the meaning of subsection (1) of section 6 of the Salford Hundred Court of Record Act 1868(c) in which the debt or damages sought to be recovered shall not exceed the sum of seven hundred and fifty pounds.

2. This Order may be cited as the Salford Hundred Court of Record (Extension of Jurisdiction) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1970.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order increases the jurisdiction of the Salford Hundred Court of Record in personal actions from £500 to £750. (The jurisdiction was increased to £500 by the Salford Hundred Court of Record (Extension of Jurisdiction) Order 1966 (S.I. 1966/430)).
