The Special Constables (Pensions) (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1971

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 26 of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967(a) (as read with section 1(2) of the Police Pensions Act 1961(b)), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consultation with the Joint Central Committee and such bodies and associations as are mentioned in section 26(9)(b) of the said Act of 1967, I hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Special Constables (Pensions) (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1971 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1971.

2. In these regulations any reference to the Instrument of 1971 is a reference to the Special Constables (Pensions) (Scotland) Regulations 1971(c), as amended (d).

3.—(1) In the application of the Police Pensions Regulations 1971(e) to the calculation of an award to or in respect of a special constable under the Instrument of 1971, those regulations shall apply as amended by the Police Pensions (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1971(f) (amendments necessary or expedient in connection with the passing of the Pensions (Increase) Act 1971(g)).

(2) In accordance with paragraph 1 of this regulation, for regulation 3(1) of the Instrument of 1971 (which, as set out in the Special Constables (Pensions) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1971(h), defines the expression "the principal regulations") there shall be substituted the following paragraph:—

"(1) In these regulations the expression "the principal regulations" means the Police Pensions Regulations 1971 as amended by the Police Pensions (Amendment) Regulations 1971(i) and the Police Pensions (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1971.".

4. In regulation 4(2) of the Instrument of 1971 (special constables' supplemental pension) the reference to regulation 106 of the principal regulations shall be omitted and, accordingly, for the words "67 and 106" there shall be substituted the words "and 67".

5. Regulation 12 of the Instrument of 1971 (limitation on application of regulation 106 of the principal regulations) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Special Constables (Pensions) (Scotland) Regulations 1971 which give to special constables and their dependants certain pension benefits for which members of police forces and their dependants are eligible under the Police Pensions Regulations 1971.

The Police Pensions (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1971 contain amendments to the Police Pensions Regulations 1971 which appear necessary or expedient in connection with the passing of the Pensions (Increase) Act 1971 and come into operation on 1st September 1971 (the date from which increases authorised by the 1971 Act are payable).

These regulations, which come into operation on the same date, make similar provision in connection with the passing of the 1971 Act as respects the benefits payable to or in respect of special constables.
