# The Friendly Societies (Fees) Order 1971

Made - - 22nd November 1971

Laid before Parliament 30th November 1971

Coming into Operation 1st December 1971

The Treasury pursuant to the powers conferred upon them by section 9(1) of the Friendly Societies Act 1971(a) and to all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Friendly Societies (Fees) Order 1971 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1971.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. Fees may be charged on the registration of a friendly society, benevolent society, cattle insurance society, working-men's club or old people's home society, and on the registration of an amendment of the rules thereof, in accordance with a scale determined by the Treasury under section 96(1) of the Friendly Societies Act 1896(c).
