TRANSFER OF OFFICERS

PART I

Description of officers

- 1. The following officers, being officers employed for not less than one half of their time on duties of the specified class in connection with property transferred by article 3.—
 - (a) officers engaged on the collection of rents being—
 - (i) estate officers; or
 - (ii) temporary rent collectors;
 - (b) resident estate officers;
 - (c) old peoples wardens; or
 - (d) other officers being—
 - (i) resident caretakers and assistant caretakers;
 - (ii) resident stoker/plant attendants;
 - (iii) non-resident porters;
 - (iv) temporary relief porters; or
 - (v) cleaners.
- **2.** Any other officers specified by the Greater London Council with the approval of the transferee authority as being officers affected by the transfer of property by article 3. Article 18
